White Oak

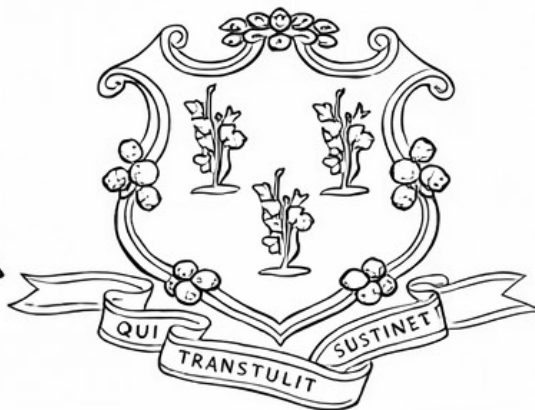

- They serve as habitat and food for birds, squirrels, and insects, and are important for butterflies.

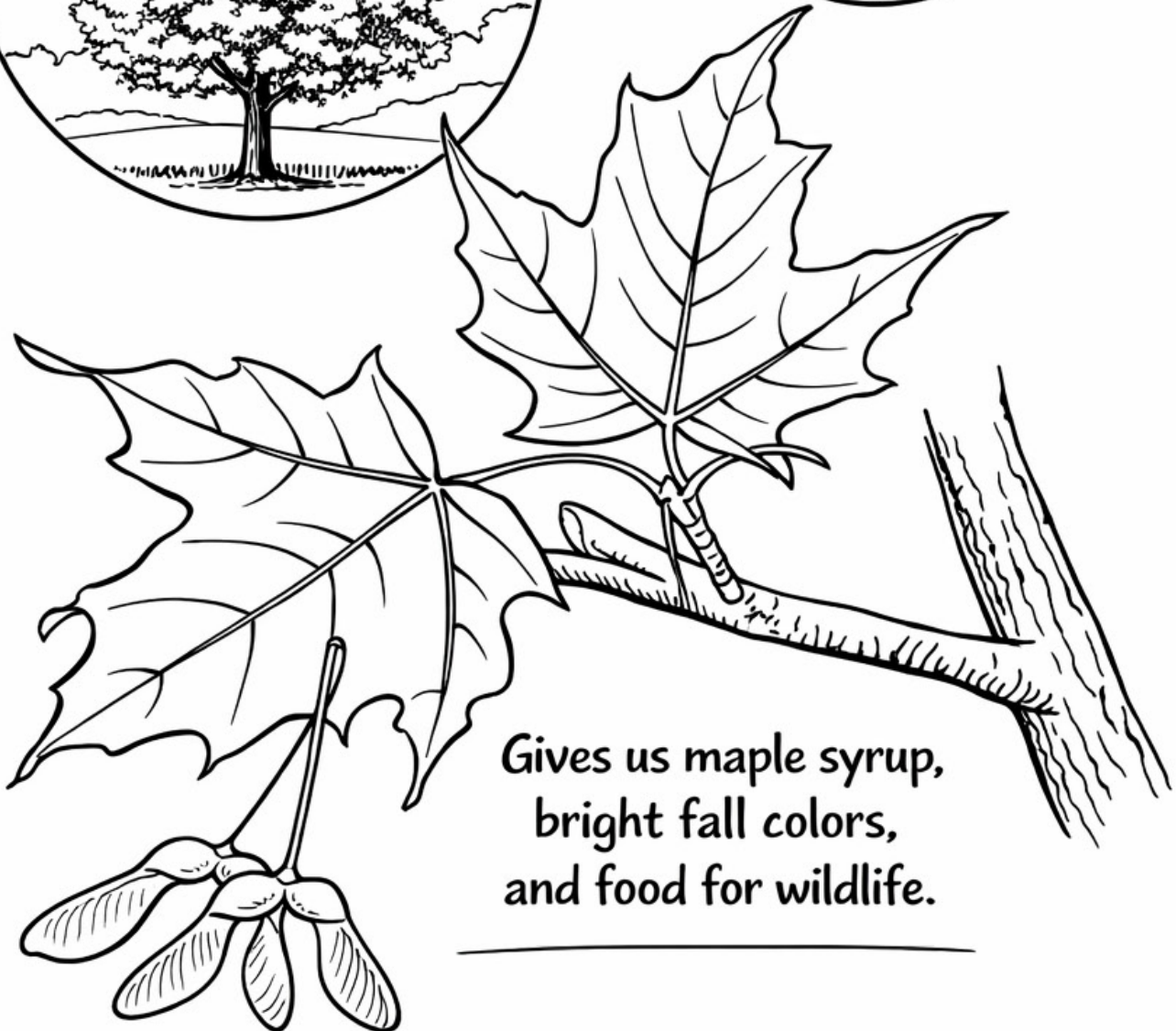
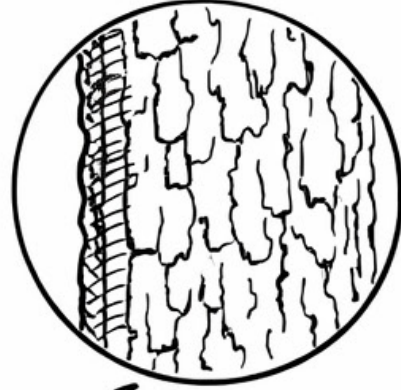
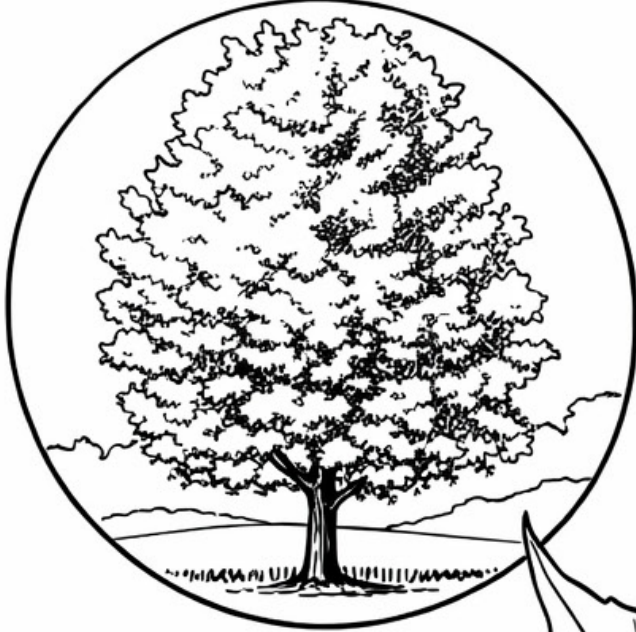


Elm trees are coming back because of scientific research!
